He then served as National Tourism Director until 1998, before continuing his career as a Prefect.

On 7 October 2013, Hugues Parant was appointed by the Minister of Regional and Housing Equality, to the position of CEO of the Etablissement Public d'Aménagement de La Défense Seine Arche, the public authority responsible for development and urban planning in the La Défense and Seine Arche districts.

On 6 March 2017, Hugues Parant is appointed CEO of the Etablissement Public d'Aménagement Euroméditerranée, a major urban development project in Marseille, an operation of national interest in the second largest city in France for 20 years.
